### Ramp Door (Emily Street Entrance)

Paris Presbyterian Church has an accessible ramp on the Emily Street on the north side of the church. Once you have entered on the Emily Street entrance through the double doors turn to your left to enter the church sanctuary. One of our greeters would be pleased to assist you at any time. If you are in need of washroom facilities turn to your right in the foyer, just inside the double doors, and you will find the washrooms on the right side. To attend socials in our hall (named the Rose Room), turn right in the foyer and then left down a short corridor which opens into the Rose Room. Should you wish to visit the administration offices of the church continue through the Rose Room into a small foyer. The office will be on your right. Please consult for hours.



### Ground Floor Entrance Door (Grand River Street Entrance)

Paris Presbyterian church also has a ground floor entrance door. This entrance is reached by following a side walk which is on the south east side of the church property on Grand River Street. Follow this side walk to the second entrance on your right. This entrance allows access to the church's dining hall, kitchen and washrooms, as well. The dining hall is the location for church lunches, our Community Dinner, which is on the last Thursday of most months and other social events. (Note: should you wish to go up to the next level (sanctuary level) you would need to access it through the Emily Street entrance.)

### **Parking and special requests**

The church has street parking on Emily Street and Grand River Street, as well as surrounding side streets. The church also has a paved parking lot on the east side of Grand River Street. There is a traffic controlled cross walk allowing you to cross safely to the west side of Grand River Street at which point you will decide which entrance will best suit your visit.
